



## Google Bulk PageRank Tool

### Instruction Guide

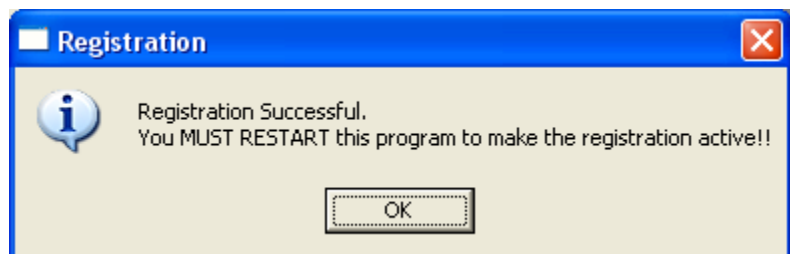
#### 1. Start Program

Start the application by double-clicking the Icon in the folder you saved it.

If you have not registered your copy, you will get a "Not Registered" message. You can either:



- Run it in Demo Mode – Do this by simply clicking "Close/Demo" at the bottom.
- Register Your Copy – Enter the serial Number you received from us. Once you enter a valid Serial Number, it will advise you to restart the program.

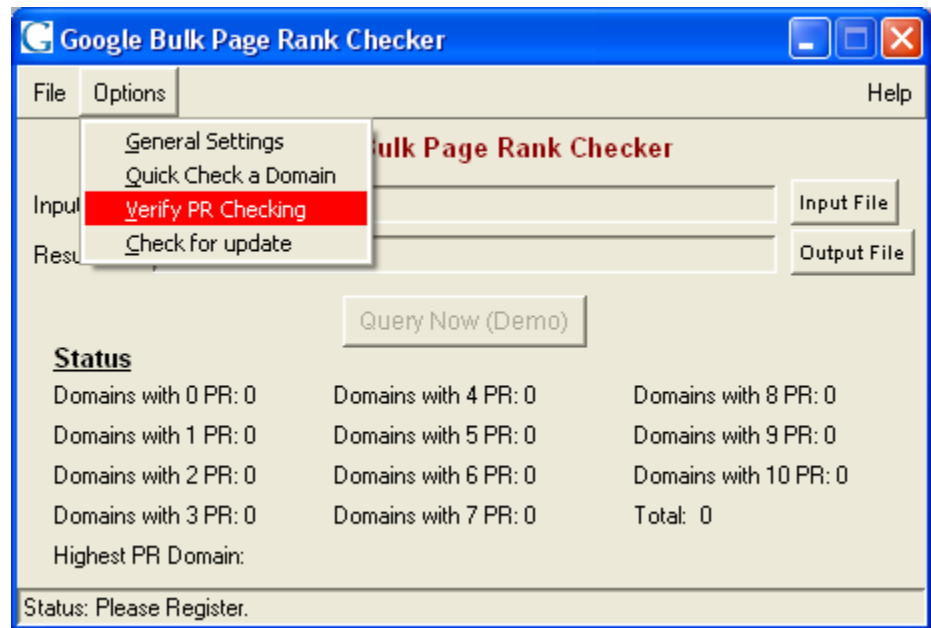




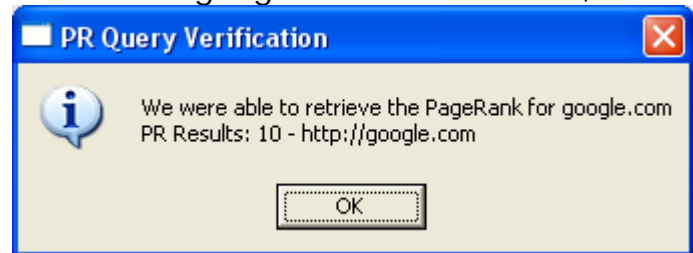
## 2. Verify PR Checking works

To perform a quick check to verify your computer is able to get PageRanking information, simply click:

Options -> Verify PR Checking



This will get the PageRank of the domain "google.com". If it works, you'll get a message like this.

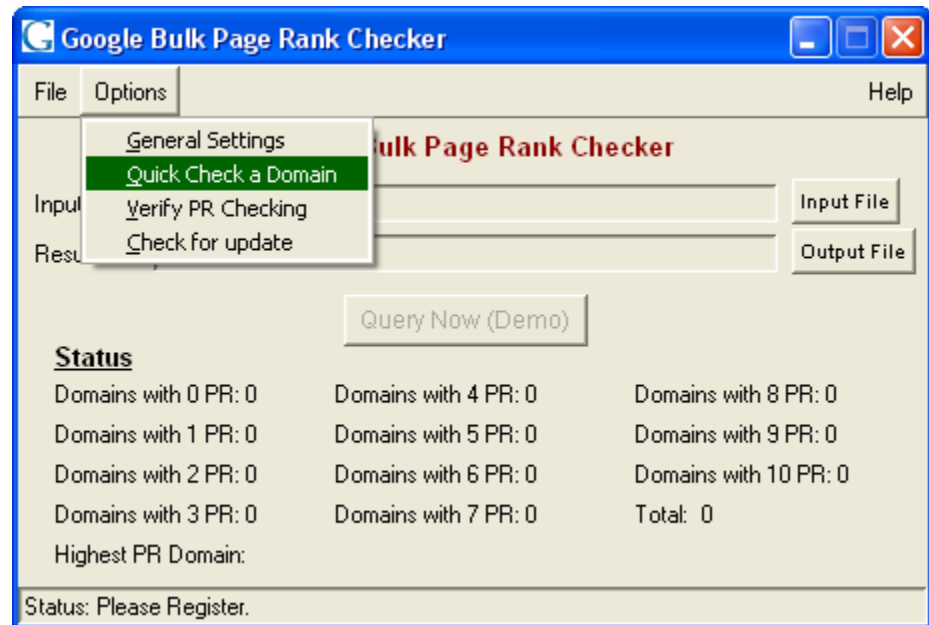




### 3. Quick Test a Domain (optional)

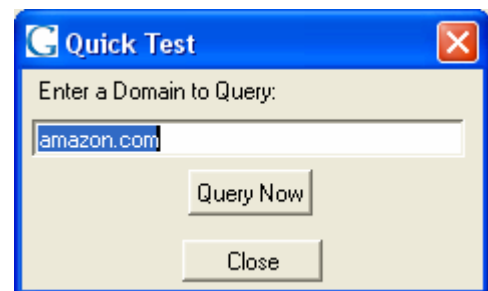
You might want to just test one or two domains. To do this, click:

**Options -> Quick Check a Domain**

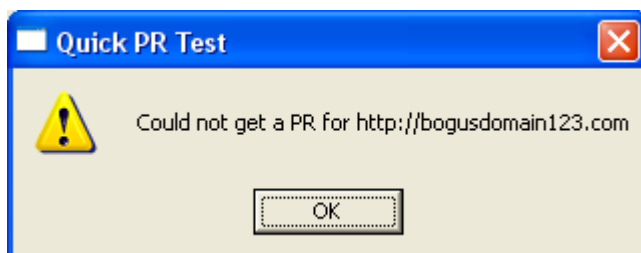
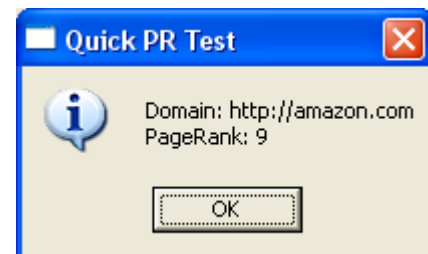


The program will prompt you for the domain to check:

Type in a domain name and click the **Query Now** button.



It will display the results in a new pop-up Window.



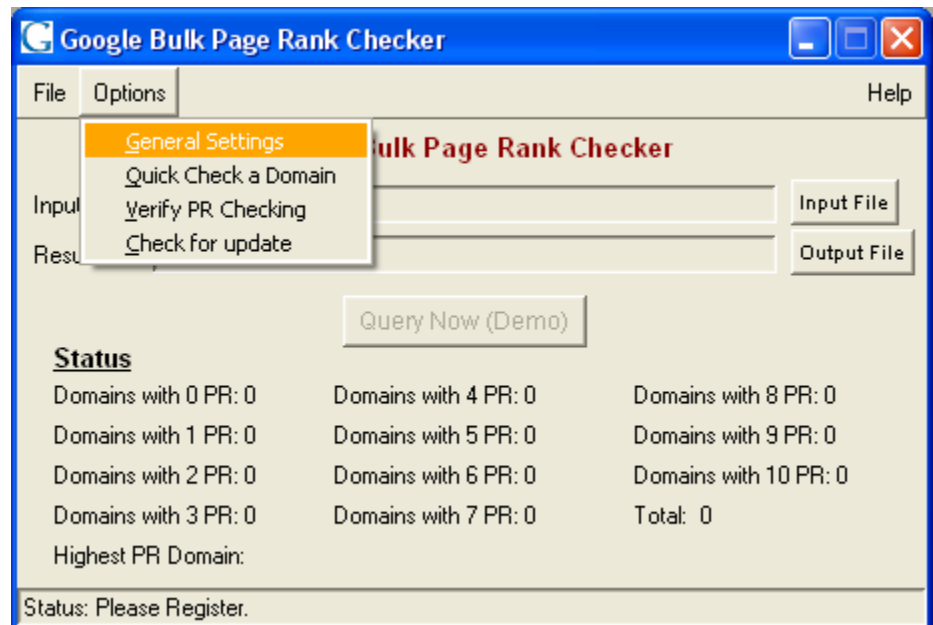
A Zero PageRank displays this message



#### 4. Adjust Program Settings

To adjust the Program's settings, click **Options -> General Settings**

Note: After you click **Save** at the bottom, the settings will be kept for future sessions. Clicking **Cancel** voids all changes.



#### Details

##### Seconds to wait between groups

How long should the program waits between groups (below) before proceeding. This is to prevent Hammering Google's servers too much, Which might violate their Terms of Service.

##### How many domains per group

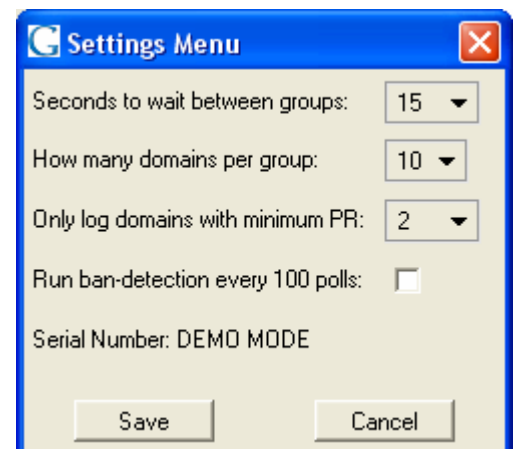
This is the number of domains the Program will poll, until it will wait (above).

##### Only log domains with minimum PR

If you only want to log domains that have a minimum PageRank, set it here. Options are: *ALL, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, or 10.*

##### Run ban-detection every 100 polls

If this option is selected, the program will try to get the PageRank of "Google.com" after polling 100 domains in the list. This is a way to see if Google has (temporarily) banned your host.





## 5. Select Input File

You need to specify the file that contains a sequential list of domain names.

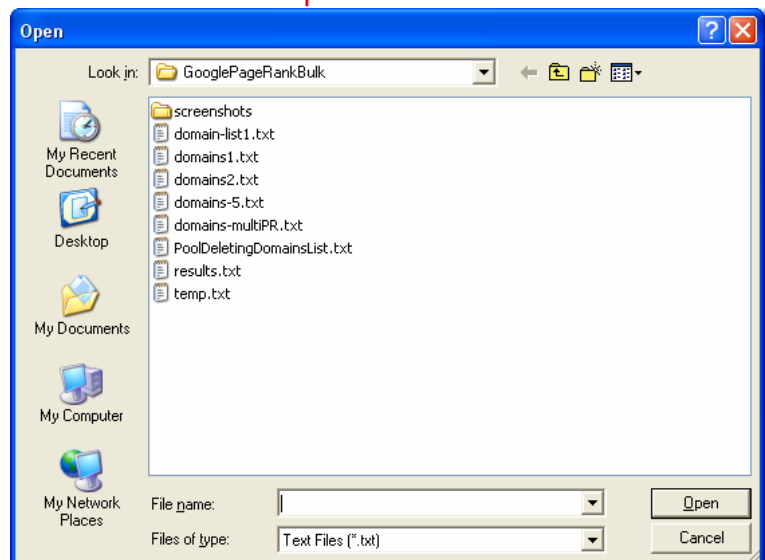
The Input File's contents should be something like:

```
amazon.com  
google.com  
godaddy.com  
yahoo.com  
mydomain.com  
mydomain2.com  
networksolutions.com
```

First, simply click the **Input File** button on the main menu.

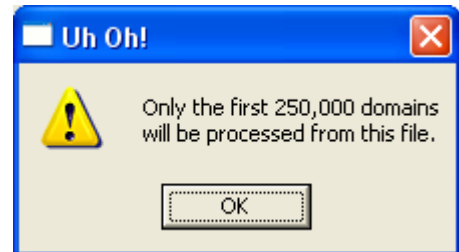


Then, *select the file* and then click the **Open** button.

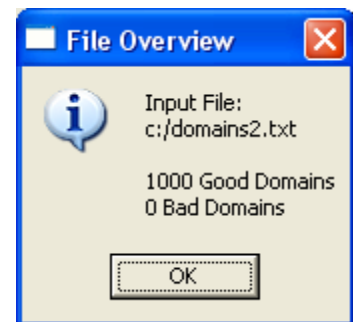




Note: If the list contains more than 250,000 valid domains, you'll get the following message. To manage RAM, this program will only queue and process a maximum of 250,000 domains per session. If you have more, simply use multiple Input Files.



Next, it will give you a *File Overview* so you'll have an idea what it's going to process.







## 6. Select Output File

Then, select the output file. This is the file that the program will save all of the results to. An example output file is <tab> delimited, with the PageRank in the first column and the Domain Name in the second column. It will look like:

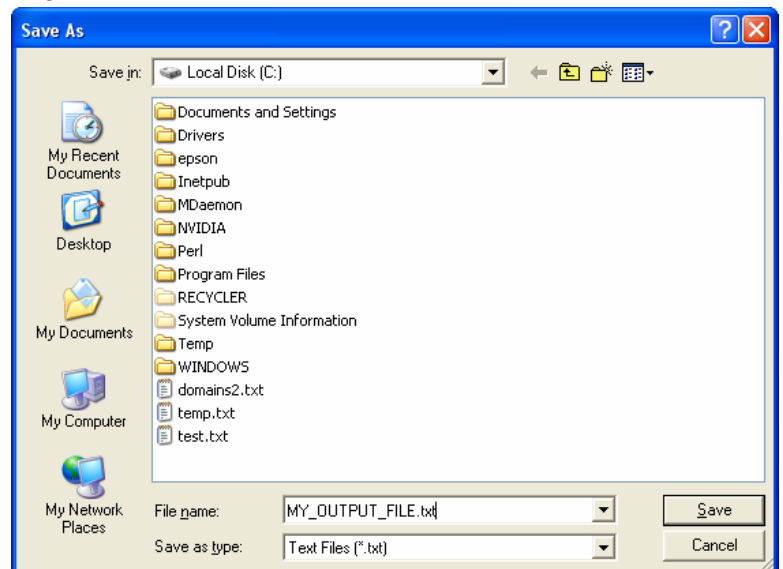

To select the output file, click the Output File button on the main menu.



Then, select a directory and type in a filename to Save the results to. Optionally, you can click to use an existing file.

**Warning:** If this file already exists, it WILL be overwritten.





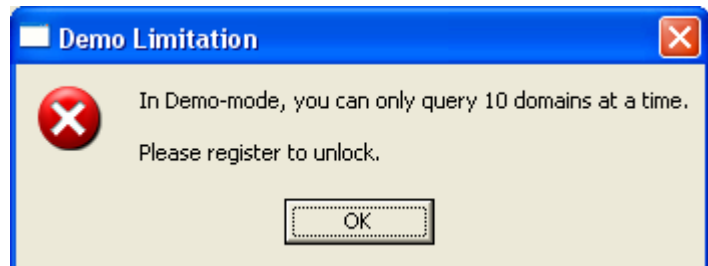
## 7. Click Query button

To start polling for the PageRanks, click the **Query Now** button on the main menu. You'll see the tool working.

Our benchmarks indicate that you should get an average of 20 Domains Queries per second (assuming your host is not banned).

Just sit back and let the Program do its job.

Demo Information: If you have an unregistered Demo, you can only query 10 domains at a time. After 10 domains are polled, you'll get the following message.







### **8. What if I am banned?**

If you hammer Google's servers too much, your host might be banned. This is usually temporary, but we cannot speculate how Google determines who to ban and for what duration. If your host gets banned, simply wait until you're unbanned, and use more conservative timer and group settings. Please review Google's Terms of Service Policy.
