

mightymacros: mixlNavigator add-in for Excel

For installation instructions please view installation pdf

Once installed right click the worksheet to activate the cell menu

Then select the Sheet_Navigator option on the menu to open the dialog

Step 1: Select the header row number

Step 2: Select the headers in the header row and 'Add to list'

Step 3: Double click the header to navigate to that column

Step 4: Turn the guide on then select any cell to position the guide

Step 5: Whilst the guide is in dynamic mode select the row where you wish to place the guide. You can then change the guide mode to 'Static' where the guide will remain fixed. To move the guide again change the mode back to 'Dynamic'. You can also grab the guide in static mode and adjust the line spacing
